Table 1: Examples of Federal Programs that Fund Transit Projects New Starts and Small Starts (FTA) Selects new fixed-guideway and fixed-guideway extensions, fixed guideway modernization, and certain bus-related projects for funding in accordance with 49 U. S. C. 5309. Projects can include heavy, light, and commuter rail, and certain bus rapid transit projects. To be eligible for funding under New Starts, projects must, among other things, be justified based on a comprehensive review of mobility improvements, environmental benefits, economic development effects land use, cost effectiveness, and operating efficiencies, and supported by an acceptable degree of local financial commitment. Small Starts are evaluated against a subset of these measures including cost effectiveness, land use, other factors (including economic development impacts), and local financial commitment. Transit Capital Assistance (FTA) Provides grants to local transit agencies through a formula for projects that can include capital projects and associated capital maintenance items, planning, transit enhancements, and operating costs of equipment and facilities. Funding is apportioned to urbanized and nonurbanized areas on...
