

There are only a few names on this map to the eastward, and none that can be recognized at the present day. The fact, however, that they gave names to places, even if the map makers knew not how to place them correctly, shows that they were well known to them. The names now referred to are all near the south end of the province, and in the same neighbourhood we might mention, among existing names, Baccaro Point, at the east end of Barrington...
