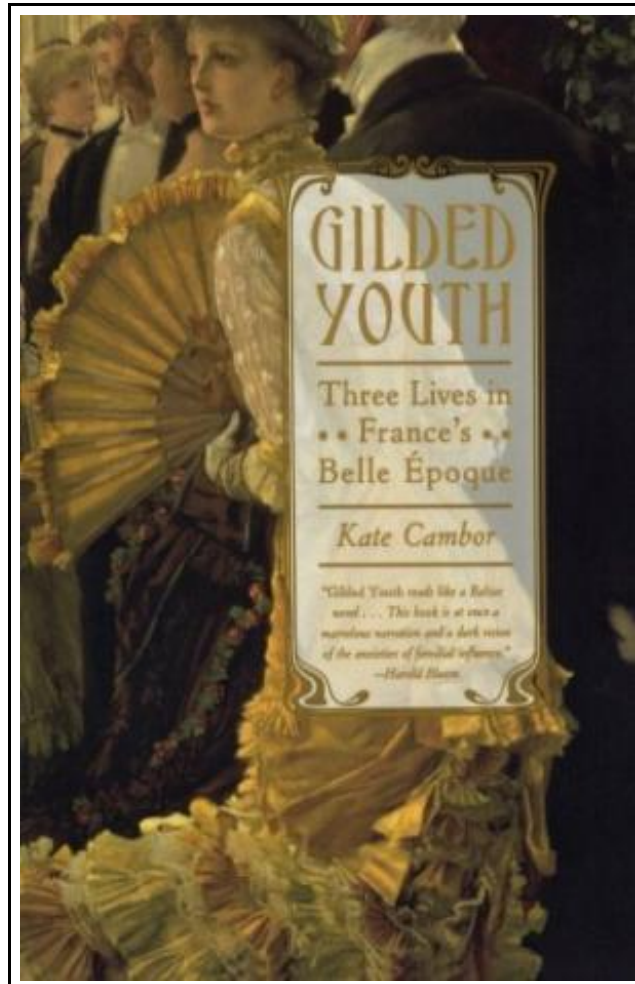


Gilded Youth: Three Lives in France's Belle Époque

And though childhood friends Léon Daudet, Jean-Baptiste Charcot, and Jeanne Hugo seemed poised for greatness, they became instead the subject of scandal, gossip, and fascination. Kate Cambor paints a portrait of a generation lost in the upheavals of social unrest, violent crime, the birth of modern psychology, and the eruption of World War I, unable to uphold the standards of their famous forebears.
