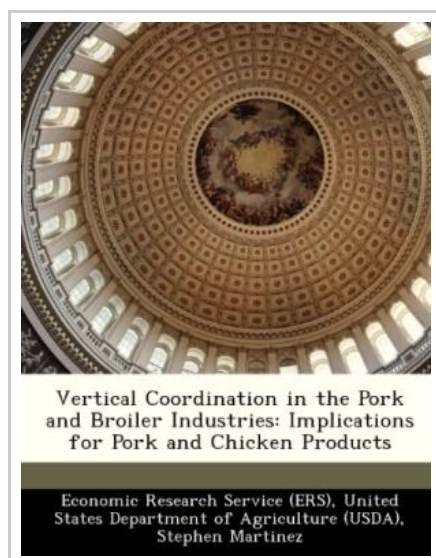




Vertical Coordination in the Pork and Broiler Industries: Implications for Pork and Chicken Products
