NEW INDUSTRIAL ERA, 1877-1900 A. REFORMS 1. John D. Rockefeller's Standard Oil dominated the market, its trust controlled 90% of the nation's oil supply. 2. Trust-busting movement - Congress passed the Sherman Antitrust Act (1890) and the Clayton Antitrust Act (1890). 3. Theodore Roosevelt's "Square Deal" aimed to protect consumers, regulate monopolies, and conserve natural resources. B. ECONOMY 1. Rapid industrialization led to a boom in production and a rise in the standard of living. 2. Urbanization led to a rise in the population of cities. 3. The Great Migration (1915-1970) saw African Americans move from the South to the North and West. 4. Immigration led to a rise in the population of cities. 5.
