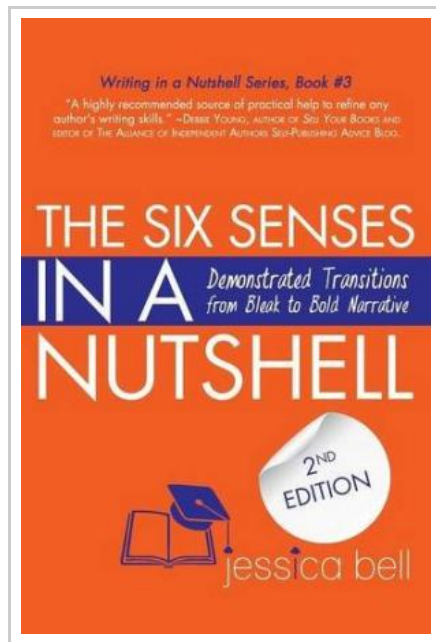




The Six Senses in a Nutshell: Demonstrated Transitions from Bleak to Bold Narrative
