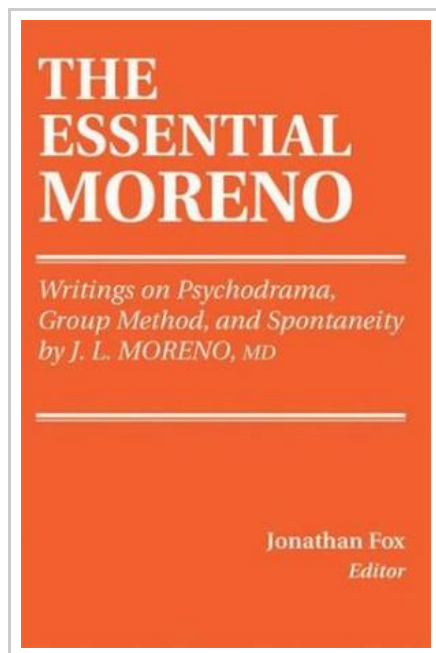




The Essential Moreno: Writings on Psychodrama, Group Method, and Spontaneity
