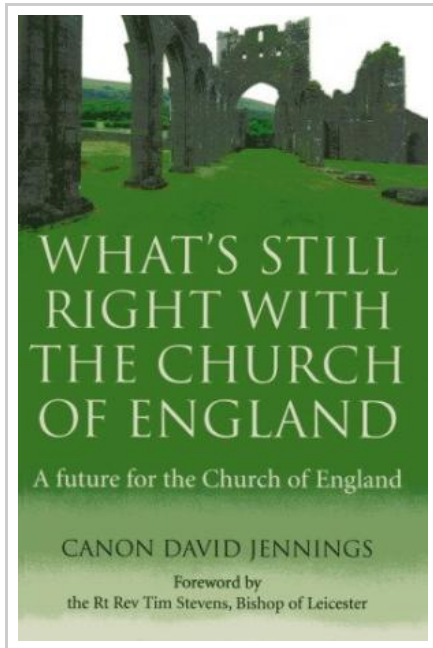




What's Still Right with the Church of England: A Future for the Church of England
